

Wine Estate Zimmermann

The Zimmermann family cultivates a total of 11 hectares of vineyards, providing interpretations of Grüner Veltliner in all its facets, from light to sweet and fizzy right through to a version fermented and matured in oak.

Sustainable methods are implemented in the vineyards, and cover crops have been in use here for the past 20 years. The Gernlüssen vineyard site is located behind the village of Gedersdorf. A mixed soil structure features loess, sand, and gravel. Inviting aromas and flavors of fruit and spice are highlighted by juicy acid in medium bodied, extremely open-hearted and vibrant Veltliner.

The vineyards producing the Grüner Veltliner Kremser Sandgrube are to be found in the eponymous large site. The vines are grown on loess soils with slightly stony layers. This Veltliner is clearly structured, has an aromatic, playful char-

acter, and provides extremely enjoyable drinking in its easy quaffing style.

Classic Gebling! This site with its pure loess soils provides very fruity Grüner Veltliners with tropical aromas, a multi-layered structure, creamy texture and persistent, full-bodied finish.

The Rosshimmel site is located above the Rohrendorfer Gebling, facing southwest, going down towards Krems, with stony clay soils. Zimmermann likes to describe the Veltliner Reserve Rosshimmel as being "bullish", which is intended to be a term including features such as opulent, full-bodied, concentrated and having a long finish.
